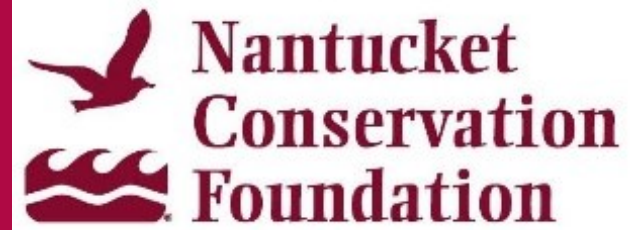
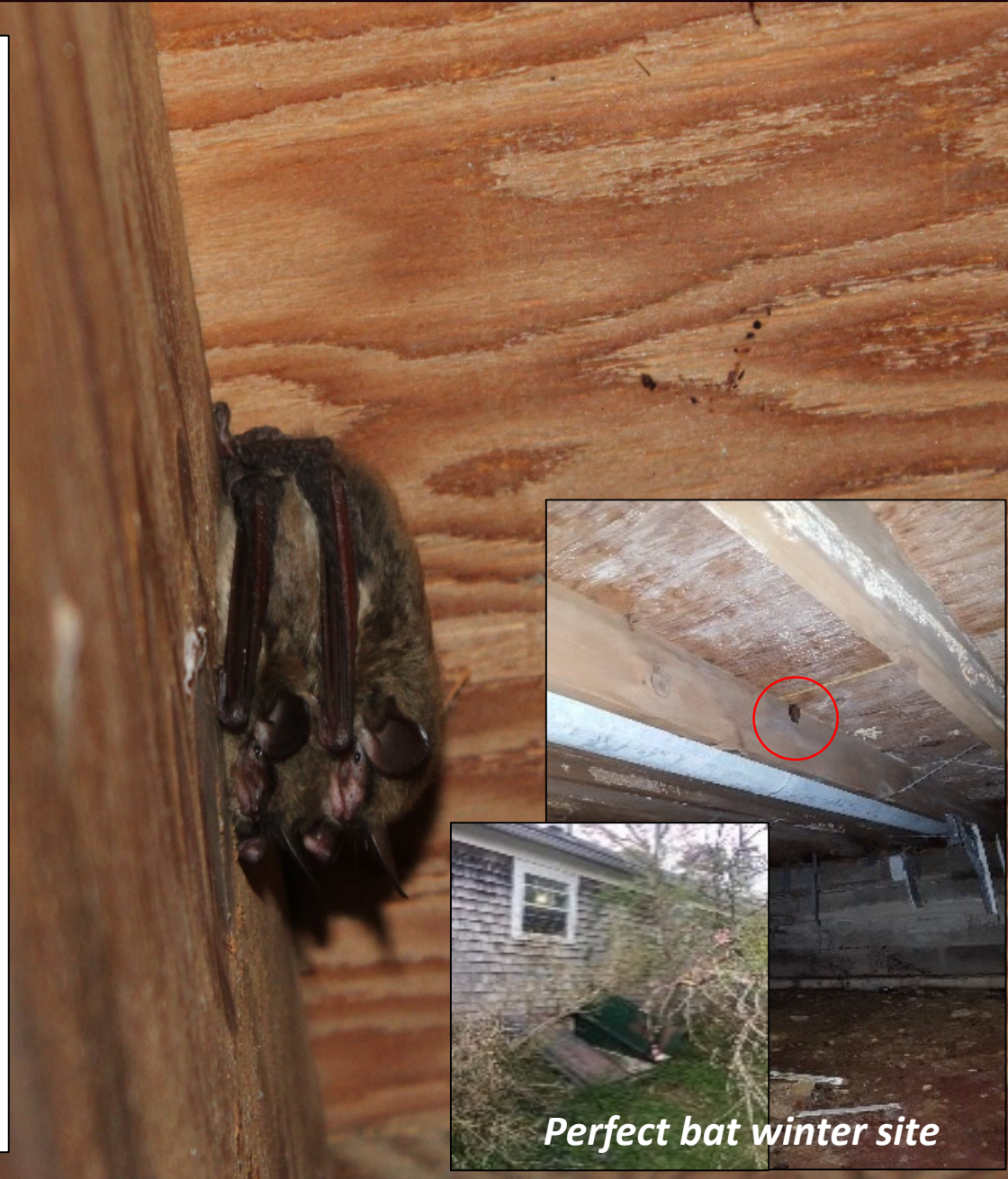


Got Bats?

We need your help finding hibernating bats!



- Northern long-eared bats are in drastic decline throughout the Northeast due to a non-native fungal disease in their hibernation sites. The good news is that they are persisting on Nantucket.
- Instead of flying to caves on the mainland for the winter, some stay here in **damp, cinder block basements or crawlspaces** - accessed through small gaps in vents or bulkhead doors.
